Dear Sir or Madam,

Gemalto, a listed company on Euronext Amsterdam (GTO|NL0000400653), has recently issued two profit-warnings on 28 October 2016 and 22 March 2017.

We are investigating the legality of the transactions performed by the company directors referred to as "insiders" shortly before these profit-warnings.

As part of your duties related to the European Market Abuse Regulation applicable in the Netherlands, we ask you to determine whether these transactions should be considered as market abuse.
